- **Excellent**: Student actively participates in all activities, every time his or her class comes to Music. Student never needs a reminder to participate. Student never requires an Action Plan or other removal from the classroom.
- **Satisfactory:** Student actively participates in all activities most times his or her class comes to Music. Student may need a reminder or two in a class period. Student never requires an Action Plan or other removal from the classroom.
- **N Needs Improvement:** Student does not participate in activities many times his or her class comes to Music. Student may need multiple reminders in a class period. Student may have received an Action Plan or other removal from the classroom.
- **U Unsatisfactory:** Student usually does not participate in activities most times his or her class comes to Music. Student may need many reminders in a class period. Student may have received more than one Action Plan or other removals from the classroom.
- *5th Grade students' grades may also be reflective of recorder participation and preparedness.

- *Students will receive a final Grade of E if they have all E's, or all E's and one S.
- *Students will receive a final Grade of S if they receive more than one S.
- *Students will receive a final Grade of N if they receive one or two N's.
- *Students will receive a final grade of U if they receive one or more U's, or three or more N's.
