Rehearsals



Rehearsals will be held on Tuesday afternoons from 2:45 - 4:00 PM in the Chorus room. Students with extra parts, such as speaking or playing an instrument, may be required to attend extra rehearsals. To have a productive rehearsal, students must show exemplary behavior. Students are expected to participate fully in every rehearsal. This involves singing, moving, and listening as directed.

If a student is disrupting rehearsal (talking, not singing, touching others, etc.), they will be removed from the rehearsal area and be put in time-out. In time-out, students are given an opportunity to change their behavior and participate correctly. If a student is removed the rehearsal area two times, he/she will no longer be allowed to participate in Primary Chorus.

Note: In some cases, a student may be removed from Primary Chorus without a time-out.

Uniform

The Primary Chorus uniform is to be worn at all performances, whether in or out of school, unless notified otherwise. Students will wear: Primary Chorus shirt, black pants, black shoes, and black socks. Jewelry is fine as long as it is kept simple. On cold days, a solid long-sleeved shirt may be added underneath the chorus shirt.

Attendance

Attendance will be taken at each rehearsal and performance. If a student is not in his/her place on time, he or she will be counted absent. Students are expected to attend every rehearsal and performance for the entire duration. We have a lot of really exciting, challenging repertoire we will be learning. Students who do not attend rehearsal consistently will not be able to learn the material and will not be prepared for the performance. Students who have an unexcused absence a performance will no longer be able to participate in Primary Chorus.

If a student is absent from Primary Chorus rehearsal, he/she must bring Ms. Blanchard a note from a parent the day following a missed rehearsal for an excused absence. If no written excuse note is received within three days of the absence, the student will be marked as unexcused. Excused absences include absence from school, doctor's appointment, etc. Forgetting is NOT a valid excuse for missing rehearsal. The note must be written and signed by the parent, or it may be e-mailed by the parent to:

Students are allowed one unexcused absence per performance period. If a student has more than one unexcused absence, he/she may not be allowed to attend a performance or may be removed from Primary Chorus. The number of excused absences allowed will be evaluated based on the number of rehearsals before a performance.

We want to teach our children to be responsible citizens, and part of that is teaching them to be respectful of one another's time.



Dismissal

Please make sure your student has a ride home promptly at 4:00. Students should be picked up in the Car Rider Lane in the back of the school. Students are allowed one late pick-up. Students picked up late more than once will be removed from Primary Chorus. Additionally, students that leave rehearsal early more than once will be removed from Primary Chorus.

Due to the number of Primary Chorus members, there is typically a line of cars waiting to pick-up students. **Please remain in your car**. We will walkie-talkie the name of your student to an adult inside the building and your student will come outside. We will try to do this as quickly as possible.

Parents are expected to be in the Car Rider Lane at 4:00. As long as there is a line of cars, students will not be counted as late. However, when the line ends, all remaining students are counted as late. If a parent chooses not to get in line at 4:00 and pulls up slightly later, you risk being counted as late.

Being in Primary Chorus is a privilege. I love providing extra musical enrichment for students. I am volunteering this time. I am not volunteering time after 4:00 to wait for students to be picked up. If you know you will not be able to pick up your student at 4:00, please communicate that to your student so he/she does not stay for Primary Chorus.

We want to teach our children to be responsible citizens, and part of that is teaching them to be respectful of one another's time.

Note: If a student is picked up after 4:30, he/she will be removed from Primary Chorus immediately.


